Essential Skills & Requirements:

- Willingness to work in districts and blocks across Khasi, Jaintia & Garo regions and travel to remote areas.

- Candidates will undergo a Written Examination and Interaction Round as part of the selection process.
- The written test will consist of the following components:
General Knowledge, Aptitude & Reasoning, Psychometric Test, and Subject Matter.

Eligibility & Conditions

- Candidate must be a resident of Meghalaya.
- Minimum age: 18 years and above and maximum 45 years.
- The candidates will be awarded stipend (Rs. 7,000 per month) during their Apprenticeship program as per the organizational policy.
- Apprentices will be required to maintain 90% attendance and submit a work report upon completion of training.
- Selected candidates will be placed across various districts/blocks of Meghalaya for the training.
- TA/DA for approved field visits will be provided as per MBDA/MBMA policies.
